

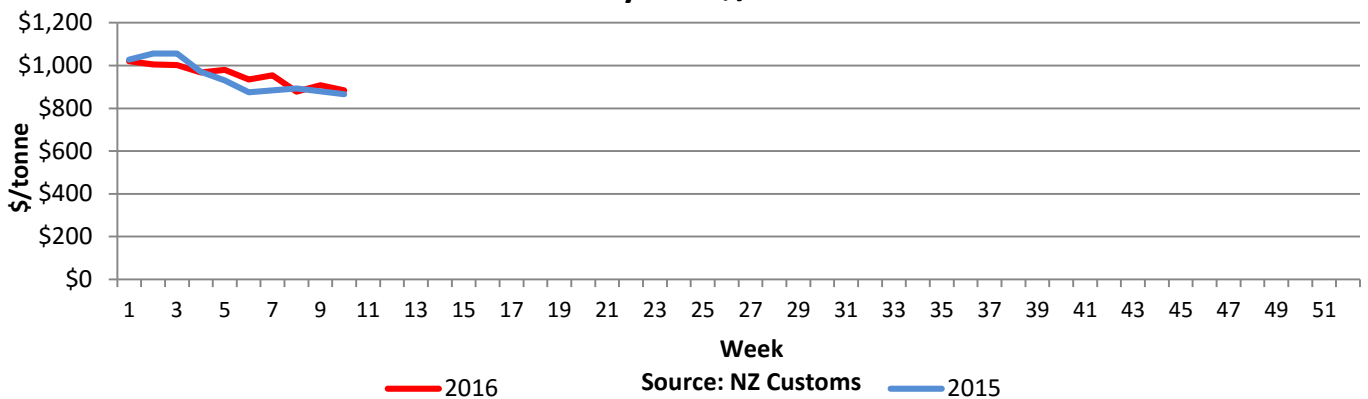

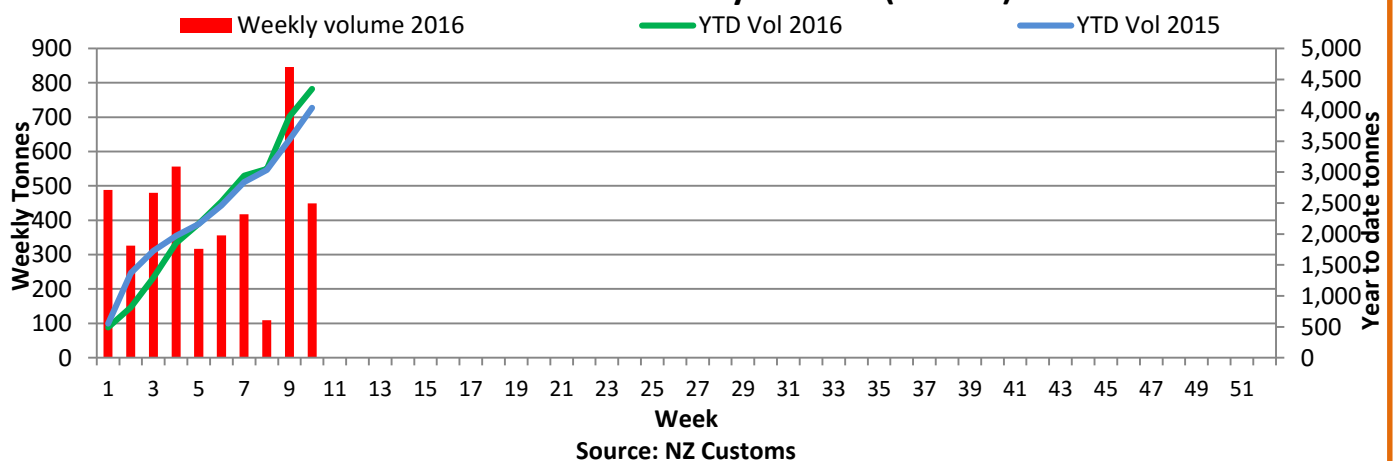

<sup>1</sup> The weekly FOB\$/tonne figure is a derived value obtained by dividing the FOB value by the volume. It does not represent the farm gate price or export price. FOB value is the value submitted to NZ Customs by exporters and is the declared value of the consignment at the point of export. Value (\$/tonne) figures are not recorded if the volume for the country is less than one tonne.

<sup>2</sup> NZ Customs also captures data for fresh potato that are shipped on passenger cruise liners. This volume is recorded in 'other' where the country is not specifically listed in the table
