- Links to industry issues & programmes





Level 2.	Aimed at experienced agrichemical users, managers & supervisors
Applied level	Specialist skills e.g. calibrators
Approved Handler certification	 Higher level of technical knowledge. Workshops and field events
Level 1 . Introductory level	 General agrichemical training course. Awareness of risks and responsibilities. Trained to apply agrichemicals under instruction.
