Reminder for all seed growers

At planting and during growth:

- Individual varieties in the field must be kept separate by at least the equivalent of one clear row between different varieties
- At least 5 metres of clear row must be left at each end of the first row of each seed-line of the same variety, be clearly marked, and be visible from the centres (clearly marked means marked with a flag, visible post or marker at each end of the row)
- Each seed-line must be readily identifiable in the field throughout the growing season.

Minimum information required on seed plot labelling:

1. Variety
2. Planted and harvested generation or at least harvested generation
3. Seed source (Seed sown Reference No).
