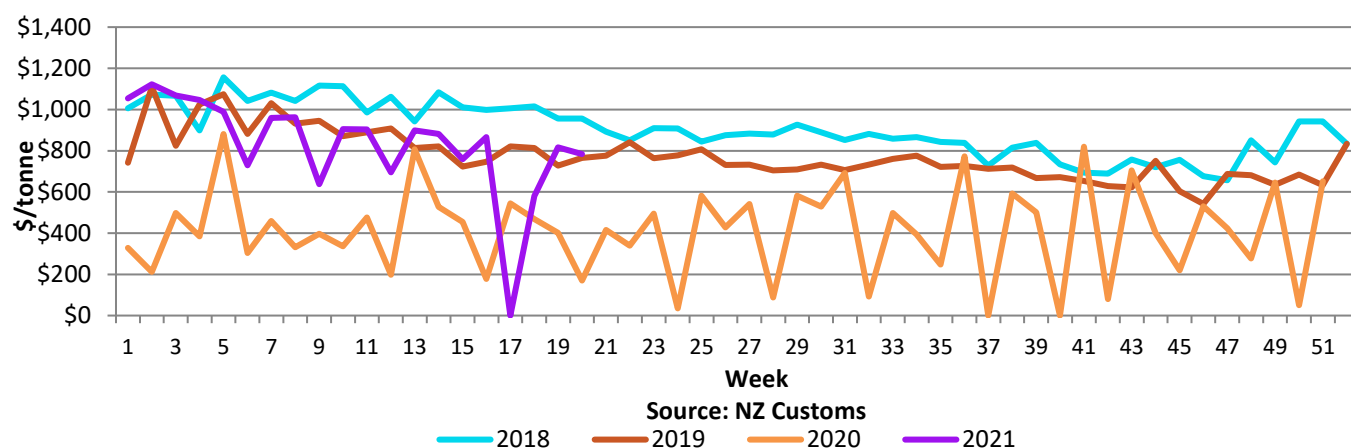

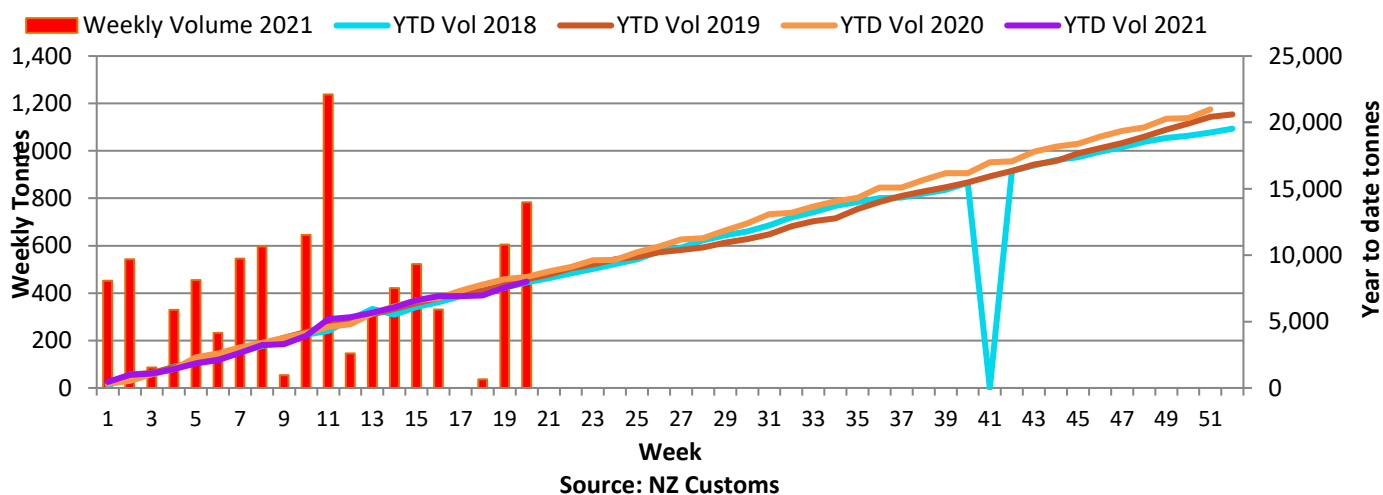

Weekly figures are not recorded if the volume for the country is less than half a tonne.
