Sampling

Submit up to 10 leaves or 25 roots per clean/new plastic bag, making sure not to cross contaminate sub samples.

- 1. Samples should be kept cool at all times. Courier in chilly bin with ice pack. Separate samples from ice pack to avoid frost damage to samples.
- 2. If necessary, tubers will be sprouted until suitable leaves have developed for tests. This may take several months.
- 3. For sample sizes for export, consult the Importing Country Phytosanitary Requirements (ICPRs)
- 4. Meristem plantlets are grown-on in a green house and each plantlet will be tested individually.
